The Story


Shades of Home is a new body of work that marks a shift in my creative process, shaped by the places I walk, the people around me, and the habits I've built along the way.

This exhibition has been deeply influenced by the creative community here in Folkestone. Being surrounded by other artists has encouraged me to experiment, take creative risks, and focus on what feels honest.

As someone with dyslexia, I've learned that doing what I love; walking, observing, creating, is the key to staying focused and producing my best work. This series reflects that mindset: slower, more instinctive, and rooted in the place I call home.






